# Digital Buddy Scheme

**Do you have a family member, friend or neighbour within your social bubble that would benefit from being online but needs some support?**

Lancashire Adult Learning are providing a **FREE**, live, online tablet course to help get people online and access relevant services and apps safely. Delivered by a fully qualified teacher, learners will work at their own pace supported by their own family or friends (digital buddy) to complete the course.

We will be running a live online introduction course followed by a 4 week live online course starting in September. The course is aimed at residents with little digital skills who will be supported by a family member or friend (digital buddy) within their social bubble to help them through the course. To take part the digital buddy and learner will require an internet enabled tablet device, if this is not possible but a course of this type would be of interest please let us know as we may be able to provide a tablet for the learner to take part.

The live sessions will help with digital skills such as:

- Basic tablet skills
- Communicating online (Face time etc.)
- Shopping and accessing services online
- Being safe online
